A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THAT ALL PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT HOSPITALS OF THE PROVINCE OF ISABELA, TOGETHER WITH THEIR RESPECTIVE PHARMACY DEPARTMENTS AND DIALYSIS CENTERS, ARE OWNED, OPERATED, AND CONTROLLED BY THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF ISABELA

WHEREAS, the Provincial Government of Isabela, through its healthcare system, continuously provides medical, pharmaceutical, and related health services to the people of the Province in the pursuit of accessible, efficient, and quality public healthcare;

WHEREAS, the hospitals established and maintained by the Provincial Government of Isabela, including their respective pharmacy departments and dialysis centers, form part of the integrated provincial healthcare system and operate under the administration, supervision, and control of the Provincial Government of Isabela;

WHEREAS, based on official records and existing administrative and organizational structures of the Province, the following Provincial Government hospitals, together with their respective pharmacy departments and dialysis centers, are owned, operated, and controlled by the Provincial Government of Isabela:

WHEREAS, there is a necessity to formally confirm and certify the ownership, operation, and control of the aforementioned Provincial Government hospitals, including their respective pharmacy departments and dialysis centers, for legal, administrative, and regulatory purposes, particularly in compliance with the requirements of the Food and Drug Administration (FDA);

WHEREFORE, upon motion of the Honorable Emmanuel Joselito B. Añes, duly seconded and unanimously approved by all the Members present in a session duly assembled, it was —
