**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE REPROGRAMMING OF THE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND PESOS (₱1,450,000.00) FROM THE GENDER AND DEVELOPMENT ACCOUNT TO FUND THREE (3) PROJECT/PROGRAMS/ACTIVITIES PROVIDING SEMINAR ON LAWS PROTECTING INDIGENOUS PEOPLES AND WOMEN, SKILLS DEVELOPMENT, AND CAPACITY BUILDING**

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The Gender and Development (GAD) Program is mandated to ensure the promotion, protection, and advancement of the rights and welfare of women and marginalized sectors, consistent with national laws and policies on gender equality, social inclusion, and human development.

This proposed ordinance seeks to approve the reprogramming of the amount of One Million Four Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (₱1,450,000.00) from the Gender and Development (GAD) Account to fund three (3) Projects/Programs/Activities (PPAs) that directly support the objectives of the GAD framework. These PPAs include: a seminar on laws protecting Indigenous Peoples and women, skills development initiatives, and capacity-building activities for targeted beneficiaries.

The conduct of these programs is intended to enhance awareness and understanding of existing laws that safeguard the rights of Indigenous Peoples and women, strengthen individual skills for livelihood and productivity, and build institutional and community capacities to promote inclusive development and gender responsiveness.

The reprogramming of funds ensures the optimal utilization of the GAD budget in addressing current needs and priorities, while remaining aligned with the principles of gender equality, empowerment, and social protection. Approval of this ordinance will enable the timely implementation of the identified PPAs and reinforce the Province's commitment to inclusive, equitable, and sustainable development.

In view of the foregoing, approval of this ordinance is earnestly sought.

**Section 3. Utilization of Funds.** The disbursement and utilization of funds to be made pursuant to this Ordinance shall adhere to existing government budgeting, accounting, and auditing laws, rules, and regulations.


**Section 4. Authority to Reprogram.** To ensure that the resources and development plans of the Provincial Government of Isabela are responsive to the current development issues and that its programs, plans, and activities are effectively implemented, the Governor is hereby empowered to augment or reprogram any savings that may be derived from the herein reprogrammed funds to any item within the same appropriation.


**Section 5. Effectivity.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.


