### EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 12 Series of 2026

#### **AN ORDER CREATING THE ISABELA LOCAL INFRASTRUCTURE AUDIT TEAM (ILIAT) FOR THE CONDUCT OF INFRASTRUCTURE AUDIT IN THE PROVINCE OF ISABELA**

**WHEREAS**, the Philippines is ranked as the most disaster-prone country in the world, frequently experiencing high-magnitude earthquakes that result in significant loss of life and damage to infrastructure;

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991," mandates Local Government Units (LGUs) to ensure and support the health and safety of their inhabitants and promote the general welfare;

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 10121, or the "Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010," requires the establishment of local disaster risk reduction and management programs to manage the impacts of natural hazards;

**WHEREAS**, DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2025-071 establishes the **Infrastructure Audit (IA) Program** to assess the vulnerability of local public infrastructure and coordinate national and local actions in preparation for high-magnitude earthquakes;

**WHEREAS**, the LGU is highly encouraged to establish an audit team to support the implementation of the IA Program and provide policy direction.

**NOW THEREFORE, I, RODOLFO T. ALBANO III**, Governor of Isabela, by virtue of power vested in me by law and the Constitution do hereby create the Isabela Local Infrastructure Audit Team (**ILIAT**) for the conduct of Infrastructure Audit in the Province of Isabela

**Section 1. CREATION AND COMPOSITION.** The Isabela Local Infrastructure Audit Team (ILIAT) is hereby created and shall be composed of the following:

**Section 2. FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES.** The ILIAT shall perform the following duties:

- 1. Inventory & Prioritization:** Conduct an inventory of LGU-owned and lifeline vertical infrastructure and perform a prioritization assessment using the Harmonized IA Tool.
- 2. Work Plan Development:** Prepare and submit an IA implementation work plan to the DILG Provincial Office within one month of the issuance of the policy.
- 3. Conduct of Audit:** Execute the actual infrastructure audit according to the approved work plan using the Harmonized IA Tool.
- 4. Reporting:** Submit a copy of IA results to the DILG for evaluation and upload monthly summary reports to the designated portal by the 5th day of every succeeding month.
- 5. Policy Integration:** Recommend actions based on audit findings and ensure recommendations are integrated into the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan (LDRRMP), Comprehensive Development Plan (CDP), and Comprehensive Land-Use Plan (CLUP).

**Section 3. SCOPE AND FREQUENCY OF AUDIT.** The team shall prioritize LGU-owned and lifeline vertical infrastructure (e.g., government offices, schools, hospitals). Regular audits shall be conducted based on the following frequency:

- **Every Year:** National or world cultural relics (e.g., historical churches).
- **Every 3 Years:** Evacuation centers, health facilities, public markets, public schools, and water utilities.
- **Every 5 Years:** Provincial halls, fire/police stations, and power/communication-related buildings.

**Section 4. FUNDING.** Financial and logistical support for the ILIAT, including tools and service vehicles, shall be sourced from the **Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (LDRRMF)**, specifically the 70% allocated for pre-disaster preparedness and risk reduction.

**Section. 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** If any provision of this Order is declared invalid, the other provisions not affected shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 7. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE.** This Implementing Rules and Regulation shall take effect immediately upon the date hereof and shall remain in effect until rescinded, repealed or amended.
