EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 15 Series of 2026

REORGANIZING THE COMPREHENSIVE DEVELOPMENT PLAN TECHNICAL ASSESSMENT OF COMMITTEE (CDP-TAC) AND TECHNICAL ASSESSMENT COMMITTEE SECRETARIAT (TACS) FOR THE ASSESSMENT OF THE CDPs COMPONENT CITIES AND MUNICIPALITIES PROVIDING FOR ITS COMPOSITION, ROLES, AND RESPONSIBILITIES

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160 or the Local Government Code of 1991 mandates all cities and municipalities to prepare a Comprehensive Development Plan (CDP) that outlines the key goals and objectives, challenges, and concerns facing local government units and identifies a set of programs, projects, and policies to attain its vision and mission towards a sustainable and holistic socio-economic development;

WHEREAS, RA 7160 further provides that the Local Development Council is the body mandated by the LGC to prepare the multi-sectoral development plan of an LGU thus it is critical to ensure that the LDC as well as its functional and sectoral committees, as providers of technical support and assistance are constituted and activated including the technical working group for that purpose;

WHEREAS, DILG Memorandum Circular 2018-172 Comprehensive Development Plan Assessment for Component Cities and Municipalities provides that the Provincial Development Council thru a Special Functional Committee created for the purpose, shall assess the CDPs of its component cities and municipalities for compliance to established guidelines on the formulation of CDP; its alignment with the Provincial Development and Physical Framework Plan (PDPFP), Provincial Development Investment Program (PDIP), Comprehensive Land Use Plan (CLUP); and to national development thrusts and strategic directions as part of the province's share oversight function with concerned national government agencies;

WHEREAS, DILG Memorandum Circular 2021-037 provides the updated guidelines and guidance for the assessment of CPDs of cities and municipalities in light of the integration of DRR-CCA considerations in the CDP assessment process and parameters;

WHEREAS, the separation, transfer and/or promotion from office of the members of the CPD-TAC, have resulted in vacancies in the membership of the committee, herein, there is a need to reorganize the CDP-TAC to ensure its continuing mandate and functions;

NOW THEREFORE, I, RODOLFO T. ALBANO III, Governor of the Province of Isabela, by the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the reorganization of CDP-TAC, as follows:

SECTION 2. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Section 2.1 CDP Technical Assessment Committee (CDP-TAC) functions:

- a. Assess the CPDs of all component cities and municipalities in the province;
 - The DILG Provincial CDP Focal Person shall spearhead the conduct of the technical assessment for the *Form* and *Process* components.
 - The PPDC, together with the Provincial Department Heads and regional line agency representatives, shall spearhead the conduct of the technical assessment for the *Content* component to include the alignment of the CPD with the PDPFP and PDIP.
- b. Participate in technical activities for the assessment results for the assessment of the CDP;
- c. Facilitate endorsement of assessment results to the Governor as chair of the PDC; and
- d. Provide advisory assistance to the C/MPDC as may be deemed necessary and in consideration of recommendations made as contained in the *BLGD CAT Form 1: CDP Assessment Checklist* and *BLGD CAT Form 1-A: Mainstreaming Sector/Thematic Concerns*.

Section 2.2 Technical Assessment Committee Secretariat (TACS)

- a. Assist in the administrative preparation, coordination for the convening of the CDP-TAC, and documentation of assessment sessions;
- b. Consolidate results of the assessment and pertinent documents for endorsement to the PDC;
- c. Upload scanned copies and Excel files of the CDP Assessment Checklist in the Google Drive; and,
- d. Provide other administrative support to the CDP-TAC as may be necessary.

All orders, circulars, memoranda, rules, regulations, and other issuances or parts thereof that are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, modified or amended accordingly,

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately and let copies hereof be provided to all concerned for their information, reference, and guidance.
