**AN ORDER REORGANIZING THE PROVINCIAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD
 (PSWMB) OF THE PROVINCE OF ISABELA**

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the State, as embodied in Republic Act 9003, otherwise known as the "Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000," to adopt a systematic, comprehensive and ecological solid waste management program to protect public health and the environment;

WHEREAS, under RA 9003, Local Government Units (LGUs) are primarily responsible for the implementation and enforcement of the Act's provisions, in coordination with the National Solid Waste Management Commission (NSWMC), other concerned agencies, and sectors;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160, or the "Local Government Code of 1991," empowers the Provincial Governor to enforce laws and ordinances and to ensure the delivery of basic services and the management of programs such as solid waste management;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Isabela, through Resolution No. 007, Series of 2001, authorized the creation of the Provincial Solid Waste Management Board (PSWMB) of the Province of Isabela;

WHEREAS, due to the recent changes in the composition of elected officials, reassignment, separation from service, and the transfer or promotion of representatives from member agencies, there is a need to reorganize and update the membership of the Provincial Solid Waste Management Board to ensure proper representation and enhance the effectiveness of its functions;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RODOLFO T. ALBANO III, Governor of the Province of Isabela, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the **REORGANIZATION OF THE PROVINCIAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD (PSWMB)** as follows:

Section 1. Composition of the PSWMB.

The reorganized PSWMB shall be composed of the following:

Section 3. Functions of the PSWMB.

The PSWMB shall perform the following functions and responsibilities:

- a) Review and integrate the solid waste management plans of the component cities and municipalities, and develop a Provincial Solid Waste Management Plan (PSWMP), for submission to the National Commission;
- b) Oversee the implementation of the Provincial Solid Waste Management Plan;
- c) Identify areas within the Province with common solid waste management issues for integrated planning and solutions;
- d) Recommend policies and measures to mitigate pollution and conserve the natural ecosystem;
- e) Mobilize resources for the implementation of Solid Waste Management (SWM) programs and projects;
- f) Promote clustering of LGU's to address shared SWM challenges;
- g) Develop incentive schemes as part of the Provincial Solid Waste Management Plan;
- h) Coordinate and support the SWM efforts of component LGUs;
- i) Convene joint meetings with LGU SWM Boards at least quarterly to monitor and evaluate program progress;
- j) Review the Provincial SWMP every two (2) years or as necessary to ensure its relevance and effectiveness;
- k) Represent LGU concerns in inter-agency coordination with national government offices;
- l) Provide logistical and technical support to component LGUs as authorized under section 17 (f) of RA 7160; and
- m) Perform such other functions as may be necessary to implement RA 9003 effectively.

Section 4. The PSWMB Secretariat.

The Environment and Natural Resources Office (ENRO) of the Province shall serve as the Secretariat and Technical Working Group (TWG) of the PSWMB. It shall have the following duties:

1. Serve as the technical arm of the PSWMB in the implementation of RA 9003 and its implementing rules and regulations;
2. Provide technical and administrative support to the Board in all its functions and undertakings;
3. Perform other tasks as may be assigned by the PSWMB to ensure effective and efficient implementation of the Provincial Solid Waste Management Plan.

Section 5. Budgetary Requirements.

The funding requirements for the operations of the PSWMB and its secretariat shall be sourced from the Office of the Governor and/or other available funds, subject to the usual budgeting, accounting, and auditing rules and regulations.

Section 6. Repealing Clause.

All prior issuances, orders, rules, and regulations, inconsistent with this Executive Order are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.

Section 7. Effectivity.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
