**REORGANIZING THE PROVINCIAL ANTI-DRUG ABUSE COUNCIL (PADAC)  
FOR THE PROVINCE OF ISABELA**

**WHEREAS**, it is the duty of the State to safeguard the well-being of its citizens from the harmful effects of dangerous drugs on their physical and mental well-being, and to defend the same against acts or omissions detrimental to their development and preservation;

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 9165 also known as the "Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002, calls for the active participation of Local Government Units (LGUs) in the implementation of the provisions of the law with preference to the prevention or educational programs and the rehabilitation and treatment of drug dependents;

**WHEREAS**, the Local Government Code of 1991 mandates LGUs to pursue and undertake to improve public morals and maintain peace and order, among other equally significant concerns;

**WHEREAS**, DILG- DDB Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2018-01 dated May 21, 2018 provides for the new composition of Local Anti-Drug Abuse Councils to intensify the functionality and operating capability of the local councils;

**WHEREAS**, the use of illegal drugs is still prevailing and is significantly affecting the peace and order in the different communities in the province, thus, a comprehensive and strategic action to curb the use and distribution of illegal drugs must be implemented;

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to organize the *Provincial Anti-Drug Abuse Council for the Province of Isabela (PADAC- Isabela)* which is a multi-sectoral body that contributes to policy-making, rehabilitation of drug dependents, the effective implementation of the anti-illegal drugs campaign and will function as the monitoring and coordination arm of the Provincial Government of Isabela relative to all issues and matters regarding the use and distribution of illegal drugs;

**NOW THEREFORE**, I, **RODOLFO T. ALBANO III**, Governor of Isabela, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby issue this order reorganizing the **PROVINCIAL ANTI-DRUG ABUSE COUNCIL FOR THE PROVINCE OF ISABELA (PADAC-Isabela)**, which shall be composed as follows:

**Section 1.** The Provincial Anti-Drug Abuse Council (PADAC) shall perform the following functions, to wit;

1. Ensure the formulation of PADAC Action Plan that contains the PPAs identified in the Municipal and City ADAC Action plans;
  - a. Organize the PADAC Drug Reformation Committee and adopt the Program of Instructions for Drug Reformation Program
2. Approve substantial amount of budget;
3. Ensure functionality of the lower ADACs;
4. Conduct of regular meetings;
5. Analyze and review reports submitted by CADAC/MADAC Secretariat;
6. Submit all collated quarterly reports to RPOC Secretariat not later than the 15th day of the ensuing quarter, copy furnished the Provincial Peace and Order Council and the DILG Provincial Office;

| d. For the 4th Quarter Period- | Not Later than 15th day of January of ensuing year |
7. Ensure the establishment and operation of the Special Drug Education Center for out of school youth (OSY) and street children;
  8. Provide support for the operationalization of the Community- Based Rehabilitation Program, at the component municipalities and cities.
  9. Performs other related functions and responsibilities as may be assigned by competent authorities.

**Section 3. Secretariat.** The Isabela Public Safety Office (PSO) shall act as the Secretariat for the Provincial Anti Drug Abuse Council. As such the PSO shall:

- a. Handle the administrative, operational and technical works of the PADAC;
- b. Prepare plans and programs as directed by the Council subject to the body's approval;
- c. Supervise, direct, and monitor for the Council of approved policies and programs; and
- d. Act as a liaison with appropriate agencies of the government and private sector.


**Section 4. Meetings.** The PADAC-Isabela shall convene on quarterly basis or as often as needed.

**Section 5. Funding.** The funding requirements for the operations of the PADAC shall be sourced from available funds, subject to the usual budget, accounting, and auditing rules and regulations.

**Section 6. Repealing Clause.** All issuances, orders, rules and regulations, or parts thereof that are inconsistent with any provision of this Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

**Section 7. Effectivity.** This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
