EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 21

DIRECTING ALL LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVES AND NATIONAL GOVERNMENT AGENCIES WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE PROVINCE OF ISABELA TO SUBMIT A SEMI-ANNUAL LIST OF ALL INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS INCLUDING THE CORRESPONDING PROGRAM OF WORKS, REQUIRING PROJECT ACCEPTANCE BY LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVES, AND CREATING A TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP FOR THE PURPOSE

WHEREAS, Section 25 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that national agencies and offices with project implementation responsibilities shall coordinate with one another and with the local government units (LGUs) involved in the discharge of their functions;

WHEREAS, Article 55 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA 7160 mandates that national agencies shall involve LGUs in the planning and implementation of all national projects and programs within their respective jurisdictions;

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the State to ensure the safety of all infrastructure facilities and securing for all public works the highest efficiency and the most appropriate quality in construction;

WHEREAS, Section 17 of RA 7160 mandates all local government units to exercise such powers and discharge such functions and responsibilities that are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective provisions of basic services and facilities;

WHEREAS, the Provincial Government of Isabela (PGI) upholds the principles of good financial housekeeping and transparency in the implementation of all government projects;

WHEREAS, various national agencies such as the DPWH, NIA, DOH, DepEd, DA, DOST, and other similar offices implement infrastructure projects within the Province of Isabela;

WHEREAS, consistent assessment relative to quality assurance and compliance with plans and specifications is necessary for both on-going and completed projects;

NOW THEREFORE, I, RODOLFO T. ALBANO III, Governor of Isabela, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby direct:

SECTION 1. SEMI-ANNUAL SUBMISSION OF PROJECT DATA. All Local Chief Executives (LCEs) and National Government Agencies (NGAs) operating within the Province of Isabela are hereby directed to submit a comprehensive list of

all infrastructure projects, actual and planned, including their corresponding Program of Works (POW), every six (6) months.

SECTION 2. COMPOSITION. All submissions and related correspondences shall be filed with and processed by the Office of the Provincial Administrator to ensure administrative efficiency and compliance.

SECTION 3. PROJECT ACCEPTANCE. To ensure that all infrastructure projects align with local development standards and community needs, the Local Chief Executive of the concerned municipality or city shall perform the final acceptance of any and all infrastructure projects implemented within their respective territorial jurisdictions.

SECTION 4. MATERIALS TESTING. The Office of the Provincial Engineer shall continue to conduct materials testing on all on-going projects to ensure adherence to national quality standards.

SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE AND SANCTIONS. Failure to comply with this order may result in an endorsement for a recommendation of revocation of contract or the discontinuance of the project.

LET COPIES hereof be furnished to all concerned Government Agencies and the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for their information and perusal.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
